## Review of Reporting Process

1. Parent Meetings/Trainings: October
2. Gather data and submit to appropriate person
3. Once all data has been collected it should be entered the online form: [camome.org](http://camome.org)
4. Acknowledgement of receipt will be sent to primary contact
5. Send Opt-Out forms to Chancery – it is not necessary to send a copy of the online report.
6. The entire process should be completed by December 1, 2010. Any extension request must be approved by Diocesan staff.
